Dear Sir:

This application for amendment to Appendix A of the Indian Point 3 Technical Specifications reflects a proposed change to the containment Integrated Leakage Rate Test (ILRT). This proposed change modifies pages 4.4-1 and 4.4-8 of the Technical Specifications. This change will allow an ILRT duration of less than 24 hours in accordance with an NRC approved methodology.

The proposed changes are contained in Attachment I to the Application for Amendment enclosed with this letter, while the associated Safety Evaluation is provided in Attachment II.

Enclosed for filing is the signed original of a document entitled, "Application for Amendment to Operating License," together with one copy of Attachment I and II thereto, comprising a statement of the proposed changes to the Technical Specifications and the associated Safety Evaluation.

In accordance with 10 CFR 50.91, a copy of this application and the associated attachments are being submitted to the designated New York State Official.


