Dear Sir:

This application for amendment to the Indian Point 3 Technical Specifications reflects the reorganization of the New York Power Authority headquarters staff. The reorganization is designed to improve the Authority's ability to produce and distribute low-cost electricity in New York State. Staff engineering and construction management functions will be merged into existing operations departments, and the number of management layers in other departments will be reduced. Changes resulting from the reorganization which affect the Technical Specifications are detailed in Attachment II.

Enclosed for filing is the signed original document entitled, "Application for Amendment to Operating License," together with one copy of Attachments I and II thereto, comprising a statement of the proposed changes to the Technical Specifications and the associated Safety Evaluation.


