Regarding The Removal of Containment Isolation Valves UH-37 and UH-38

Dear Sir:

This application for amendment to the Indian Point 3 Technical Specifications reflects the removal of Containment Isolation Valves UH-37 and UH-38. The technical specification changes to Table 3.6-1 and Table 4.4-1 (page 5 of 7) will eliminate the need for maintaining and testing valves UH-37 and UH-38.

The proposed changes are contained in Attachment I to the Application for Amendment enclosed with this letter, while the associated Safety Evaluation is provided in Attachment II.
