Dear Sir:

This application seeks to amend Appendix A of the Indian Point 3 (IP3) Operating License, sections 3.3, 4.5, and 6.9, to incorporate technical specifications for the two toxic gas monitoring systems at IP3. These proposed technical specifications follow the guidance and intent of NUREG-0737 Item III.D.3.4 ("Control Room Habitability Requirements"), and Generic Letter 83-37, "NUREG-0737 Technical Specifications."

Reference 1 proposed incorporating technical specifications for the two toxic gas monitoring systems into the IP3 technical specifications. Reference 2 stated that the Authority would revise the Reference 1 submittal to reflect the use of the "short term exposure limit" for the gas monitor alarm setpoints. This application to amend Appendix A of the IP3 Operating License supersedes the Reference 1 amendment application.

Enclosed for filing is the signed original of a document entitled, "Application for Amendment to Operating License," together with one copy of Attachments I and II thereto, comprising a statement of the proposed changes to the Technical Specifications and the associated Safety Evaluation.


