This application for amendment to the Indian Point Unit 3 Technical Specifications proposes to revise sections 2.7 and 3.7 of Appendix B of the Operating License. These proposed changes specify the Lower Limits of Detection (LLD) and reporting levels for Iodine-131 (I-131) in environmental samples of non-drinking water.

The proposed changes are contained in Attachment I to the Application for Amendment enclosed with this letter, and the associated Safety Evaluation is provided as Attachment II.
