Dear Sir:

On November 9, 1979, (IPN-79-80) and February 21, 1980, (IPN-80-19), the Authority submitted a revised Emergency Plan to the Commission in accordance with the Commission's October 10, 1979 letter.


The revised plan was prepared in accordance with "Emergency Planning Review Guideline Number One - Revision 1, Emergency Planning Acceptance Criteria for Licensed Nuclear Power Plants", dated September 7, 1979, and NUREG-0610.

The revised Indian Point Unit 3 Emergency Plan, described above, will become effective on August 1, 1980.

The procedures to implement this Plan will become effective within 90 days of the Plan effective date.

This matter has been discussed with Mr. L. Olshan of your staff.
