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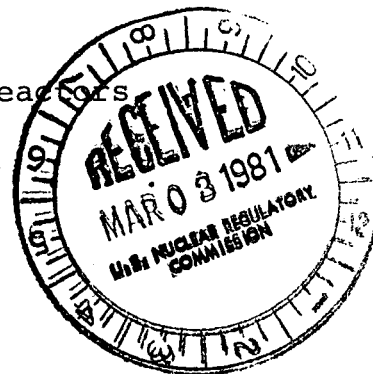

Dear Sir:

On February 17, 1981, the Authority received your February 11, 1981 letter which provided an Equipment Evaluation Report containing the preliminary results of the Commission's review of environmental qualifications of electrical equipment at the Indian Point Unit 3 (IP-3) facility.

Presently, the IP-3 facility is shutdown in order to perform unplanned repairs to the main turbine generator. Accordingly, prior to bringing the plant above the cold shutdown condition, the Authority will provide a written statement, signed under oath or affirmation, which supports the safe operation of the IP-3 facility and takes into account the Commission's February 11, 1981 preliminary list of deficiencies.

This matter has been discussed with Mr. L. Olshan of your staff who has indicated that this is an acceptable method of compliance with your February 11, 1981 letter.
