Gentlemen:

In response to your application for a byproduct material license dated March 7, 1962, we have issued the enclosed License No. 12-8271-1 which authorizes your use of the Budd Company Model 110AB exposure device with up to one curie of Cobalt 60.

You will note that the license lists by name the individuals who are authorized to perform in the capacity of radiographer. It is suggested that in order to give your radiography program a greater degree of flexibility and versatility you give consideration to the development of a formal radiography training program. It will not be necessary to inform the Atomic Energy Commission of the addition of radiographic personnel upon successful completion of such a program after it has been found to be acceptable by the Commission. We have enclosed a copy of a recent document prepared by this office entitled "Industrial Radiography Using AEC Licensed Radioisotopes" which will serve to give a clearer understanding of the criteria which we shall use in the evaluation of such a radiography training program.

As requested by Dr. Konneker during his recent visit to our office, we have enclosed several copies of our Standard Form AEC-313 for your use.
