As discussed in a phone conference between Mr. Steve Tilden, CBP Radiation Safety Officer (RSO), Mr. Mic McKeighan, CBP Deputy Director - Division of Occupational Safety and Health, and Dr. Sattar Lohdi, NRC Region 1, on 12 November, 2009; CBP has already taken steps to address this violation in training materials in all core VACIS and other Non-Intrusive Imaging courses provided by CBP. Training now clearly states that in the event of discovering an individual in a scan or scanning area, the scan must be suspended immediately. In addition to updating training, a Memo and muster topic for all CBP Officers was forwarded to the Assistant Commissioner, Office of Field Operations for signature and release on November 17, 2009.
