The above referenced letter provided the status of actions being performed in the balance of plant systems to improve the steam generators operation. Item 5 of the Attachment to that letter should have had the following content:

"Makeup water filters serve to prevent the ingress of resins from the demineralizer effluent into the steam generators. Additional mechanical filters have now been installed to provide this protection from all sources of makeup water."

The Authority regrets any inconvenience caused by this unintentional editing oversight and respectfully requests the replacement of the previously submitted statement with that supplied above.
