Dear Sir:

By letter dated May 2, 1988, the Authority requested that the NRC staff approve expanding the Indian Point 3 (IP3) primary Emergency Operations Facility (EOF). By letter dated February 28, 1989, the NRC staff granted the requested approval. In a telephone call with P. Kokolakis, the NRC staff requested notification of the completion of the EOF expansion. The expansion of the IP3 primary EOF has been completed.

By letter dated July 21, 1989, the Authority responded to Generic Letter 89-08. This response stated that the Authority was developing an erosion/corrosion inspection program, along with an administrative procedure that would implement the program. In a telephone call with P. Kokolakis, the NRC staff requested notification of the completion of the administrative procedure. The IP3 administrative procedure governing the erosion/corrosion program has been written and approved for use.
