Good Morning John

We received your revised response to RAI 13.03-5, EOF related ITAAC earlier this week.

After reviewing this revised RAI response, the reviewer found that it was not acceptable for the following reasons:

*In the revised response, rather than provide the requested 2 EOF ITAAC (i.e., address RG 1.206 generic AC 8.2.3 and 8.2.4), the applicant merely points to other COLA ITAAC in Table 2.3-1, and indicates that these referenced ACs address the EOF AC in generic ITAAC 8.2. While there is some substantive overlap among ITAAC, the other/referenced ITAAC AC do not appear to fully address generic ITAAC AC 8.2.3 and 8.2.4. (The overlap in some of the generic ITAAC reflects the overlap that exists in some NUREG-0654 evaluation criteria - which was used to develop the generic ITAAC table in RG 1.206. Overlapping areas were considered when the generic ITAAC table was developed.)*

*For example, for ITAAC AC 8.2.3, the applicant states that it is addressed by ITAAC Table 2.3-1 in AC 3.1.2, 3.2, and 5.2.2. None of these three referenced AC address the means for communications with principal State and local EOCs - which is included in generic AC 8.2.3.*

*Further, for ITAAC AC 8.2.4, the applicant references Table 2.3-1 AC 1.1.2 and 6.4. AC 1.1.2 only covers EAL parameters, and AC 6.4 only covers meteorological data. Generic AC 8.2.4 is broader, in that it address the EOF having "the means to acquire, display and evaluate radiological, meteorological, and plant system data*

*pertinent to determining offsite protective measures." It further provides that "[The COL applicant will identify specific capabilities.]"*

*Finally, Table 2.3-1 AC 3.1.1 through 3.1.4, and 3.2 do not address the means for communications between the EOF and principal State and local EOCs. If the applicant added AC 8.2.3 (which addresses the EOF), this would cover the deficiency in ITAAC 3.1 AC. The applicant should also consider revising the AC for Table 2.3-1 to cure this gap (see generic ITAAC AC 6.1 for Emergency Communications).*

At this time, we are requesting that you look at the response once more, in the context of the above discussion, and either identify where all of the elements in AC 8.2.3 and 8.2.4 (for the EOF) are addressed, or simply propose the (previously requested) ITAAC for generic AC 8.2.3 and 8.2.4.
