Dear Sir:

Reference 1 served to transmit proposed Radiological Effluent Technical Specifications (RETS), which would revise the Appendix B, Part II of the Indian Point 3 Facility Operating License in its entirety. Reference 2 served to transmit Amendment 51 to the Indian Point 3 Facility Operating License, which revised Appendix B, Part II thereof in response to Reference 1. Reference 2 also requested the Authority to transmit a license amendment deleting Appendix B, Part I, "Non-Radiological Environmental Protection Plan." In response to this request, Reference 3 transmitted a proposed license amendment deleting Appendix B, Part I in its entirety. Further review of this submittal and discussions with the


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staff concludes that the aquatic requirements provided by Appendix B, Part I should remain in the Technical Specifications. As such, the Authority requests that the "Application for Amendment to Operating License" transmitted by Reference 3 be withdrawn.
