INDIAN POINT UNIT NO. 3 - STATUS OF THE FES

On November 8, 1974, F. Gray and T. Bruen, OGC, and M. J. Oestmann and I met with W. Fulkerson and the ORNL IP-3 team members to discuss the status of the FES and how it addresses the Appeal Board's issues of concern in the IP-2 case. ORNL provided us with the Summary and Conclusions, the Foreword and Chapters I - IV and VI - X. Chapters V - Impacts of Plant Operation and XI - Alternatives and Cost-Benefit Analysis were provided us on Tuesday, November 12. Chapter XII - Responses to Agency Comments and the Appendices which support the impact assessment will not be available until November 18.

On November 8, we provided Fulkerson our comments on the Summary and Conclusions. We also discussed the HRFA - SOS proposed stipulation and Con Ed's proposed revisions of the conditions of the license. Con Ed provided a new stipulation on November 11. Discussions with OGC on the stipulation are continuing. Another meeting among the lawyers for the parties will be held on November 14. An ASLB prehearing conference will be held on November 26.
