Tami (and Mark)-

I spoke with Melanie Townley at SCDHEC yesterday and she said that the spill prevention plan is usually included as a BMP in the construction permit as a requirement for operation- so not required by construction permit during construction. However, she thought that the stormwater permit may cover prevention of impacts to gw during construction. She contacted the SCDHEC person over that area and forwarded me their response, which I have attached to this email. The point- spill plan is a part of the BMP required in the Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan. The attachment contains the relevant section of the SWPPP addressing spill prevention as applicable to construction.

This is Item 7 on the To-Do list from Lance and appears to apply to Sections 4.2, 5.2, and 7.2 of the EIS.
