**Subject: Response to Notice of Violation (91-22-01), Status  
of Radiation Monitor Upgrades**

Dear Mr. Cowgill:

Our January 20, 1992 response to the subject Notice committed to upgrade process radiation monitors during the current refueling outage, in order to reduce backup sampling demands. At the NRC management conference held February 5, 1992, IP3 committed to upgrade/install the following radiation monitors:

R11/12	Containment Particulate/Gas
R15	Condenser Air Ejector
R16A/B	Service Water Effluent From Containment Coolers
R18	Liquid Waste Effluent
R19	Steam Generator Blowdown
R20	Gaseous Waste Disposal
R23	Service Water Effluent From Component Cooling
R27	Plant Vent
R61	Condensate Polisher
R62	Main Steam Line

R16B and R23 are new installations; the remainder listed are upgrades to existing equipment. All hardware is installed. Listed monitors are operational with the exception of R61, which is in final testing.

R61 is a Bulletin 80-10 monitor, and is only required if a primary to secondary leak is present, a condition indicated by several other monitors including R15.

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
