PROGRAM SCOPE

Licensee is a small specialty surgery center located in Lapeer, Michigan. Licensee uses invitro kits of iodine 125 for specialty surgical procedures. Although licensed for materials under 10 CFR 35.400, this licensee has not began such practices.

Performance Observations

The inspector toured the facilities and interviewed authorized users and staff members. Licensee uses iodine 125 as a tagging agent in tissue studies following specialized surgical procedures. The inspector reviewed the licensee's surveys and procedures for decay in storage of waste material as well the storage facility. No issues were identified.

No abnormalities were noted during this inspection.
