**PROGRAM SCOPE**

The licensee is a civil engineering firm located in Maumee, Ohio. They perform soil density and asphalt testing in Ohio and West Virginia. The licensee has approximately 5 Troxler gauges. The gauges are normally stored at licensee's facility or at the project office for temporary job sites. For use at temporary job sites, the licensee adheres to all NRC gauge storage requirements. The licensee does not performed any service or maintenance activities on the gauges. The licensee employees about 6 gauge users who have completed the manufacturers training.

**Performance Observations**

Licensee described procedures used at a temporary jobsite since no such jobsite was available at this agreement state location at the time of this inspection. Interviews of licensee personnel indicated an adequate level of knowledge of radiation safety.

Independent surveys of the gauge storage area indicated minimal results. No violations of NRC requirements were identified.
