Enclosed is Amendment No. 65 to your NRC Material License No. 13-01535-01 in accordance with your original request dated July 14, 2009. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold** font.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

Please note that in accordance with my telephone conversation with your consultant, Thomas Kumpuris, License Condition No. 15 was added to your NRC license. The training conducted by the manufacturer for the TheraSphere device needs to include the operation of the delivery system, safety procedures and the clinical use of TheraSpheres. This information was missing from your application. Mr. Kumpuris agreed to the addition of this License condition.


Please also note that this amendment is issued concurrently with the termination of License No. 13-32106-01 issued to Medical Group of Fort Wayne, d/b/a Heart Center/Medical Group in accordance with your request.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions. Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.
