This letter supplements our letter to you of November 17, 1970 concerning the specific quantities of special nuclear material and byproduct material for which Con Edison requests that licenses be included in the operating license for the Indian Point Unit No. 2 facility.

It is hereby requested that in lieu of the four neutron sources of Polonium-Beryllium of 100 curies each referred to in that letter Con Edison be authorized to receive, possess and use at any one time a total of not more than twenty (20) grams of Pu-238 and not more than three (3) grams of Pu-239 contained in four (4) Plutonium-Beryllium neutron sources.
