

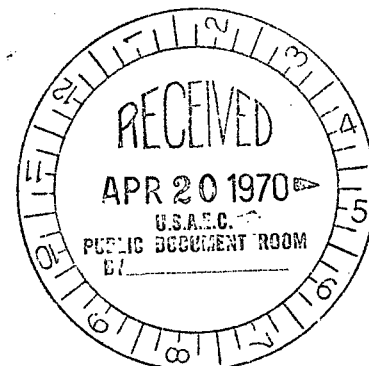

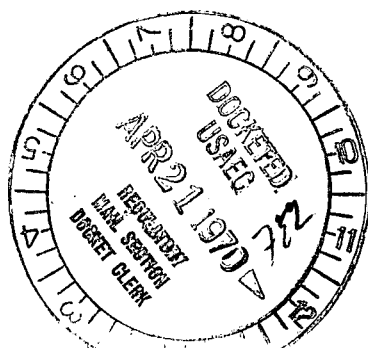

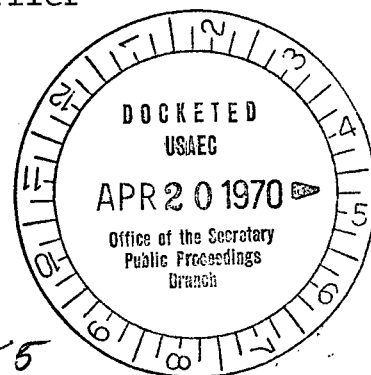

PETITION REQUESTING EXTENSIONOFCOMPLETION DATE

Pursuant to Section 50.55(b) of the Commission's regulations, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc., Applicant in the above-captioned proceeding, hereby requests that the latest completion date for its Indian Point Station, Unit No. 2 specified in Provisional Construction Permit No. CPPR-21 (as previously extended by an order of the Commission dated May 19, 1969) be extended to June 1, 1971. Licensee has experienced construction delays which make it impossible for it to meet its present completion date of June 1, 1970. These delays have been caused by a continuation of the difficulties described in the Licensee's earlier



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request for extension dated April 18, 1969 (as supplemented by a letter to Dr. Peter A. Morris from LeBoeuf, Lamb, Leiby & MacRae dated April 28, 1969); namely, difficulties with various labor unions involved at Indian Point No. 2, including strikes, and delay on the part of Westinghouse Electric Corporation in providing suitable design details for the facility.
