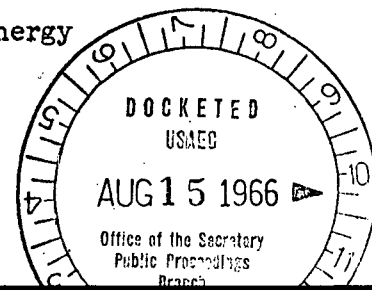

PETITION FOR LEAVE TO INTERVENE
BY THE STATE OF NEW YORK

Pursuant to Section 2.714 of the Commission's Rule of Practice and in accordance with the provisions of the Commission's Notice of Hearing dated July 29, 1966, the State of New York, acting by and through its Office of Atomic and Space Development, hereby petitions for leave to intervene in the above-captioned proceeding and become a party thereto upon the following grounds:

1. That, under Section 454 of the Executive Law of the State of New York, the Office of Atomic and Space Development is given the functions of coordinating the atomic energy activities of the agencies of the State and its political subdivisions, of cooperating with business enterprise and other persons concerned with atomic energy, the Federal Government and the governments of other states, and of correlating the atomic energy activities of the State and its political subdivisions with the atomic energy activities of the foregoing.

2. That the interest of the State of New York in the health and safety of its people requires that all matters pertaining to the safety of the nuclear power plant proposed in the above-captioned proceeding be thoroughly considered.

3. That, although under Section 274.1. of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, and Section 2.715 of the Commission's Rules of Practice, the representative of an interested State which is not a party is granted certain rights to participate in Commission adjudicatory proceedings, the interest of the State of New York in the above-captioned proceeding may require that it exercise rights which, under the Commission's Rules of Practice, appear to be available only to formal parties to the proceeding (e.g., rights under Sections 2.720, 2.741, 2.760, 2.761, 2.762, 2.764, 2.771).
