


As you requested in your letter of December 18, 1974, we are presently preparing an application for amendment to our license that would propose changes to our Technical Specifications for Indian Point Unit No. 2 air treatment systems so that they reflect your model specifications. The model Technical Specifications which you attached to your letter, however, are in a different format than our existing specifications. This requires extensive analysis of your model specifications to determine the changes required in our existing specifications.

Because of the amount of preparation that has become necessary to redraft specifications Sections 3.3, 3.8, 4.1 and 4.5, we hereby request an extension to the response date which you requested until February 28, 1975. In addition, this extension would permit us to factor in the results of recently-completed special tests of our air treatment system which were requested by the Regulatory Staff at a meeting of February 15, 1974.
