Dear Mr. Case

In response to a letter from Mr. Karl R. Goller to Mr. William J. Cahill, Jr. dated October 2, 1974, we have reviewed our present Technical Specifications and our proposed Technical Specification changes submitted on September 6, 1974 in accordance with Section 50.46 of the Commission's regulations. The proposed Technical Specifications are consistent with the evaluation submitted in accordance with Section 50.46.

We have found that there is only one instance in which the two sets of specifications cannot be simultaneously met. Section 3.3.A.1.c of both sets of specifications establishes limits for the accumulator tank volumes. As stated in my letter to you of October 21, 1974, we are maintaining the accumulator levels in accordance with the present Technical Specifications until further action is taken by the Atomic Energy Commission on our submittal of September 6, 1974.


In all other instances, the proposed and present Technical Specifications are not in conflict with each other and the facility can be operated within the limits of both sets of specifications.
