

Dear Mr. Rusche:

On behalf of Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc., we hereby transmit three (3) originals and nineteen (19) copies of the document entitled "Application for Amendment to Operating License" sworn to on July 30, 1975, together with forty (40) copies of Attachments A and B thereto. The proposed amendment is submitted pursuant to Sections 50.59(c) and 50.90 of the regulations of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission. Attachment A presents the text of the changes, and Attachment B contains an evaluation.

The purpose of this Application is to resolve an ambiguity in § 6.12.1 of the Indian Point Unit No. 2 Technical Specifications, regarding the limitation of external exposures to airborne and gaseous radioactive materials. The facility is presently shut down for a scheduled outage. In order to insure that there are no inadvertent violations of the Commission's regulations

concerning such exposures, while returning the unit to service as quickly as possible, it is respectfully requested that this Application be reviewed and approved on an accelerated basis. It is crucial at this time of year that the facility be permitted to operate to the maximum extent possible to satisfy the peak load demand of the New York metropolitan area.
