 OPERATING LICENSE

Pursuant to Section 50.90 of the regulations of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. ("Con Edison"), as holder of Facility Operating License No. DPR-26, hereby applies for an amendment to the Indian Point Unit No. 2 Technical Specifications contained in Appendix A to that license.


Specifically, Con Edison requests changes to conform Section 4.2 of the Technical Specifications with applicable ASME Section XI Code Editions as required by 10 CFR Section 50.55a(g). This application is submitted in response to requests by Mr. Robert W. Reid in letters dated April 22, 1976 and November 17, 1976.

The proposed Technical Specification changes consist of the specific revisions set forth in Attachment A to this Application. A safety evaluation of the proposed changes is set forth in Attachment B to this Application. This evalua-


tion demonstrates that the proposed changes do not represent a significant hazards consideration and will not cause any change in the types or increase in the amounts of effluents or any change in the authorized power level of the facility.
