APPLICATION FOR AMENDMENT TO
OPERATING LICENSE

Pursuant to Sections 50.59(c)(1) and 50.90 of the regulations of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (Con Edison), as holder of Facility Operating License No. DPR-26, hereby requests that Sections 1.7, 3.6 and 4.4 of the Technical Specifications set forth in Appendix A to that license be amended. This Application is submitted in response to Mr. Karl R. Goller's letter of August 7, 1975 and will conform the containment leakage testing program for the Indian Point Unit No. 2 facility with 10CFR Part 50, Appendix J.

The proposed Technical Specification changes consist of the specific revisions set forth in Attachment A to this Application. A safety evaluation of the proposed changes is set forth in Attachment B to this Application. This evaluation demonstrates that the proposed changes do not involve a significant hazards consideration and will

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not cause any change in the types or an increase in the amounts of effluents or any change in the authorized power level of the facility.
