AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO APPLICATION
FOR AMENDMENT TO TECHNICAL
SPECIFICATION (ECCS)

On July 9, 1975, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. ("Con Edison"), as holder of Facility Operating License No. DPR-26, applied for an amendment to the technical specifications in Appendix A to that License, in accordance with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's regulation on Emergency Core Cooling Systems, 10 CFR §50.46 and Part 50, Appendix K (1975).

Con Edison hereby amends that application for the purpose of submitting the document entitled, "ECCS Acceptance Criteria Analysis: Major Reactor Coolant System Pipe Rupture, Indian Point Generating Station Unit 2". Based on this report prepared by Con Edison and Westinghouse Electric Corporation, no modifications of the technical specification changes proposed in the July 9, 1975 submittal are necessary.

This report confirms the prior conclusion that the changes requested on July 9, 1975 do not involve a significant

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hazards consideration and will not cause any change in the types or increase in the amounts of effluents from the facility.
