Pursuant to Sections 50.59(c)(1) and 50.90 of the regulations of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (Con Edison), as holder of Facility Operating License No. DPR-26, hereby requests an amendment to the Technical Specifications set forth in Appendix A to that license. The requested changes would conform the Technical Specifications with Revision 4 of Regulatory Guide 1.16 (Reporting of Operating Information - Appendix A Technical Specifications) and would make editorial and typographical corrections.

The proposed Technical Specification changes consist of the specific revisions set forth in Attachment A to this Application. Attachment B to this Application identifies the proposed changes and indicates whether they are editorial corrections or changes required for conformance with Revision 4 of Regulatory Guide 1.16. A safety evaluation of the proposed changes is set forth in Attachment C to this Application. This evaluation demonstrates that the proposed changes do not involve a significant hazards
