PETITION FOR ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Notice is hereby given that by Petition dated February 6, 1976, the Public Interest Research Group filed a request for an Order to Show Cause why License Nos. DPR-5, DPR-26 and DPR-64 for Indian Point Nuclear Generating Units 1, 2, and 3 should not be suspended and why civil penalties should not be imposed. The requested order would be issued to Consolidated Edison Company and the Power Authority of the State of New York. In accordance with the procedures specified in 10 CFR 2.206, appropriate action will be taken on this request within a reasonable time.
