

Dear Paul,

In accordance with our discussion on 6 Sept, I am writing to inform you of our training plans for Indian Point Unit No. 2 personnel, many of which are scheduled for license renewal during 1973. Taking advantage of the delay in Unit No. 2 operations, we have planned a lecture series over the next three months to review subjects listed in the recent proposed revision to 10 CFR 55.33. The series will consist of 96 hours of lectures which will be tailored to the needs of our operating personnel.

The lecture series will be mandatory for all shift operating personnel holding operator or senior operator licenses on Unit No. 2. Management personnel holding licenses on Unit No. 2 to provide a backup capability will be encouraged to attend as much of the series as their duties permit.

I consider this training combined with the operational experience gained during past hot sub-critical testing and future Unit No. 2 initial critical testing and operations will be adequate for license renewal. I would be happy to provide you with further detail, if desired, or answer any questions you may have on our program.


