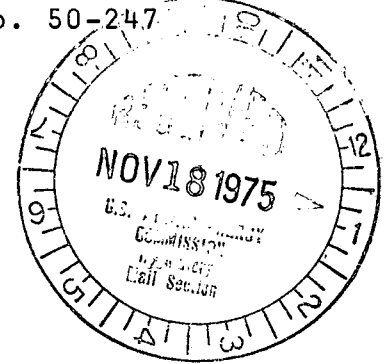

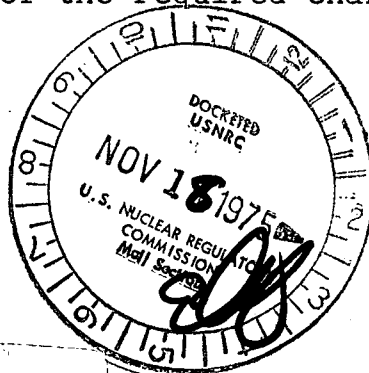


Dear Sir

My letter to you of September 9, 1975 stated that Con Edison expected to submit proposed changes to the Indian Point Unit No. 2 Technical Specifications regarding testing to meet 10 CFR Part 50, Appendix J requirements by November 14, 1975. This schedule anticipated that similar technical specifications for Indian Point Unit No. 3 would be finalized prior to November 14, 1975. However, as outlined in Mr. R.C. DeYoung's letter of November 5, 1975, several items are still unresolved.

My letter of November 12, 1975 to Mr. R.C. DeYoung transmitted a partial response to those concerns. Discussions with the Staff are continuing and the remaining items are expected to be resolved in the near future.

When the Indian Point Unit No. 3 Technical Specifications for compliance with Appendix J are finalized, Con Edison will submit to the Commission proposed changes to the Indian Point Unit No. 2 Technical Specifications incorporating a similar program. We feel that this approach will avoid duplication of effort on the part of both our staff and your staff in the preparation, review and approval of the required changes. In any event, it is


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our intention to submit a proposed change for Indian Point Unit No. 2 at least ninety (90) days before the next integrated leak rate test. The next such test will be performed during the first refueling outage for Indian Point Unit No. 2 presently scheduled to begin on April 1, 1976.
