

Dear Mr. Reid

This is to inform you that Con Edison concurs that no change to the Technical Specification is necessary to clarify heatup and cooldown criteria for Indian Point Unit No. 2. In discussions between the Staff and Con Edison held last April, it was established that the existing specifications were more conservative than the specifications proposed in Mr. George Lear's letter dated April 14, 1975. The change proposed in Mr. Lear's letter would not increase operational flexibility nor decrease the possibility of a Technical Specification violation at Indian Point Unit No. 2.

We do not plan to take any further action on this matter. Please advise us if you wish any additional information.
