


Thank you for your letter of April 2, 1975 regarding the proposed new Indian Point Unit No. 2 spent fuel storage racks. We appreciate the prompt attention given to our preliminary description of the proposed modification.

In order to obtain all the items of information you have requested, additional time beyond that previously estimated will be needed to complete the associated analyses. This additional time will also permit us to submit a more detailed description of the new racks, which we believe will facilitate your review of the proposed modification. We are therefore postponing submitting the approval request package from April 18 until May 9, 1975. Approximately ninety days will still be available in the project schedule for NRC review of the submittal.
