

Dear Mr. Jensch:

I am sending to you, under separate cover, thirty (30) copies of the report entitled "A Search for Alternatives to the Proposed Cooling Towers at Indian Point" as requested in your letter of November 1st to Mayor Bianco.

The City representative was unable to deliver these copies to your staff during the public hearing held in White Plains on December 7th because of a misunderstanding between the City representative and your staff concerning the presentation time. However, we feel that the conclusions resulting from the study regarding the use of canals and spray modules for removing heat from the reactor cooling water are important enough to receive the Board's utmost consideration in deciding on the preferred cooling method.
