Section 4.14.D.1.a of the Unit No. 2 Technical Specifications defines the surveillance requirements for the smoke detectors listed in Table 3.13-1. In the process of developing the prerequisite surveillance procedures for these particular detectors, it was found that those detectors in the areas of the boric acid transfer and containment spray pumps were not installed as was originally indicated in Con Edison's revised Fire Protection Program which was submitted to the Commission in April, 1977. A review of this situation indicates that, although shown on the applicable drawing, these detectors were intended for installation during the on-going refuel-All material for the installation is either ing outage. on hand or has been ordered and we expect that the installation will be completed before startup for the next cycle.
