Dear Mr. O'Reilly,

In a telephone conversation with Mr. John Streeter of your staff, we were requested to clarify our understanding of the time frame for scheduling our annual emergency drill. In accordance with this request, the following is submitted:

In 1975, the annual emergency drill was held on November 12, 1975. In 1976, we scheduled the annual drill for December 7, 1976. Mr. Dale Donaldson of your staff was notified on October 22, 1976. On November 3, 1976 because of the outage on Unit No. 2, we decided to change the drill date to December 28, 1976. Although the time period between the 1975 drill and 1976 scheduled drill exceeds 1 year, the Emergency Plan states only that "An annual drill shall be held----. The N.R.C. shall be notified of the impending annual drill approximately one month in advance". It is our understanding that the annual drill may be scheduled at any time during a calendar year and not necessarily within a twelve month period. We intend that future annual drills be held in each calendar year no earlier than in the quarter that preceded the previous year's drill. This will provide that our annual drill will be performed from nine to fifteen months since the last annual drill. It should be noted also that quarterly drills, designed to test various aspects of the Emergency Plan, are scheduled during the period between annual drills.
