<u>NOTICE</u> (Expected Date for Decision on Hearing Requests)

Pending before the Board are several hearing requests challenging the application of the U.S. Army Installation Command for a Source Material License to possess depleted uranium at the following two sites in Hawaii: Schofield Barracks, Oahu, and the Pohakuloa Training Area, Island of Hawaii.¹ On November 6, 2009, all the pleadings had been submitted. On November 19, the Office of the Secretary referred the case to the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board Panel (ASLBP), and on November 24, this Board was established. During a teleconference on December 8, the Board informed the participants that oral argument was warranted, and the participants indicated their availability for an argument during the week of January 11, 2010.² In light of this procedural background and the need for oral argument, the Board provides notice
