In accordance with 10 CFR 50.55a (effective February 17.09/6) and your letters dated April 22, 1976 and November 14, 1976, a review was initiated to conform the Indian Point Unit No. 2 inservice inspection and testing program with the revised requirements of 10 CFR 50.55a to the extent practical.

Enclosed is a document entitled, "Inservice Inspection and Testing Program - Indian Point Nuclear Generating Unit No. 2", which describes the updated inservice inspection and testing program for Quality Group A, B and C components and pumps and the materials irradiation surveillance specimen program. The program is in conformance with the revised provisions of 10 CFR 50.55a to the extent practical. In accordance with 10 CFR 50.55a(g)(5)(iii) and (iv), we hereby request relief from those ASME Code Section XI requirements that we have determined to be impractical for the facility. The specific areas where such code relief is necessary are identified and described in the enclosed program description.

The review for conformance with Quality Group A, B and C valve testing requirements is in progress. As discussed with members of your staff, the valve inservice testing program is now scheduled for submittal by September 15, 1977.
