In response to your August 26, 1977 request for verification of attached data, the information is correct as submitted. Please be advised, however, that the effluents reported are according to site specifications which consist of Unit 1, 2 and 3 release information. Regarding your inquiry concerning the use of the symbol for "less than", this symbol identifies the lowest detectable limit for the isotope in the sample being measured and signifies that the actual value is still lower because no reading could be obtained. However, when this occurs, the lowest detectable limit value is used in calculating total effluent discharge of the isotope.
