Per our telephone conversation today, in light of the expense associated with adding Cs-137 to your license PCB4.03, you are no longer interested in doing this. However, given that you still need to add 3 destinations (Gabon, Ghana and South Africa) via the subject amendment application, the total processing fee is \$4,600. You have sent a partial payment of \$770, therefore, an additional \$3,830 (\$4,600 less \$770) is now due. Please submit this payment so we can continue processing your application. As you stated, you will submit the additional fee after Christmas.
