Our current schedule for completing this study is May 1981 with a final report to be submitted to the NRC by June 15, 1981.

The Company has retained the services of Computech, Inc. of Berkeley, California for the re-evaluation of masonry walls. Currently, the Company is reviewing general criteria similar to that prepared by Computech for other utilities. Criteria, specific for Indian Point 2, together with the associated justification will be submitted by December 31, 1980.
