

ISSUANCE OF PROVISIONAL CONSTRUCTION PERMIT TO CONSOLIDATED EDISON COMPANY OF NEW YORK, INC., INDIAN POINT STATION UNIT NO. 2, DOCKET NO. 50-247

Pursuant to the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board's Initial Decision dated October 3, 1966, the Division of Reactor Licensing has issued Provisional Construction Permit No. CPPR-21, dated October 14, 1966, authorizing Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc., to construct the Indian Point Station Unit No. 2, at its Indian Point site in the Town of Buchanan, Westchester County, New York. The Indian Point 2 is a pressurized water reactor designed to operate at 2758 thermal megawatts. A notice concerning the issuance has been transmitted to the Office of the Federal Register for publication.

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
