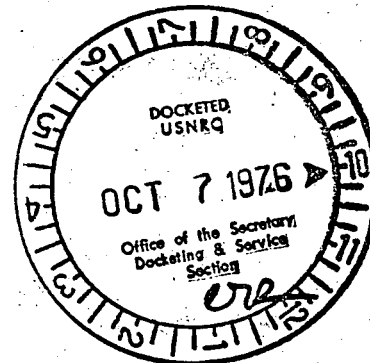

Gentlemen:

The State of New York requests that the briefing schedule in this matter be set back one week. The amended schedule would be as follows:

- October 15 CCPE and NYS Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law are due;
- November 12 Staff and Licensees Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law are due;
- November 24 CCPE and NYS Replys are due.

The new scheduling is requested because very severe cutbacks in state clerical personnel have created difficulty in producing a document of this size. In addition, the recent seismic activity at the site and the discovery of an open joint at Nyack, New York warrant verification and, perhaps, revision of certain portions of the brief.

CCPE and the Licensee have no objection to the revised briefing schedule. Mr. Grainey of the NRC staff was not available for comment at the time of this request.
