EXTENSION OF CONSTRUCTION COMPLETION DATE FOR THE INDIAN POINT STATION, UNIT NO. 2, DOCKET NO. 50-247

On November 29, 1972, the Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. requested an extension of the completion date for the construction of the Indian Point Station, Unit No. 2, which is set forth in Construction Permit CPPR-21. The request was made because of delays in the completion and associated testing of the facility due to the determination to refabricate the core and to inspect and repair, as necessary, deficiencies in particular vent/drain assemblies which were indicated during the pre-critical testing program.

Having reviewed the applicant's submission in support of this request, the regulatory staff finds that prior public notice of an order authorizing the requested extension is not required since the action does not involve significant hazards consideration and that good cause exists for the issuance of an order extending the completion date.

Accordingly, issuance of an order extending the completion date for the construction of the Indian Point Station, Unit No. 2 as presently set forth in Construction Permit CPPR-21 to March 1, 1973 is authorized. The order is to be effective on the date of the issuance.
