Dear Mr. Conway:

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc., has filed an application for a license to construct and operate a pressurized water nuclear reactor having a net electrical capacity of approximately 873 megawatts derived from a thermal capacity of approximately 2,758 megawatts.

The proposed reactor, designated by the applicant as Indian Point Station Unit No. 2, is to be located adjacent to and north of the existing Indian Point Station Unit No. 1 on the applicant's site on the east bank of the Hudson River in the Village of Buchanan, Westchester County, New York. The earliest and latest dates for completion of construction of the reactor are estimated to be January 1, 1969 and June 1, 1969, respectively.
