Dear Mr. Wilmarth:

In accordance with the understandings which were reflected in Secretary Udall's letter of March 20, 1964 to Chairman Seaborg, I am forwarding herewith an application filed by Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc., for a construction permit and facility license to authorize construction and operation of the Indian Point Station Unit No. 2 on the applicant's site in the Village of Buchanan, Westchester County, New York. The proposed reactor will be located adjacent to and just north of the existing Indian Point Station Unit No. 1.

We would appreciate receiving the results of a review by the Geological Survey of those geological and hydrological features of the proposed reactor location which may have a bearing upon our evaluation of the suitability of the proposed site.

As you know, preliminary site information for this site was transmitted to your office with our letter of October 11, 1965. The present application provides additional information relating to site suitability.

On the basis of our tentative schedule for this project, it would be desirable to have your report available for our use by February 1, 1966. By mid-January 1966 we would hope to be able to discuss with you the results of your preliminary evaluation.
