Specific 10 CFR Part 73 Requirements

Gentlemen:

References 1 and 2 requested exemption from specific requirements of 10 CFR 50.73, "Physical Protection of Plants and Materials," for Wolf Creek Generating Station (WCGS) by extending the deadline for the implementation of certain measures required by the rule.

On October 10, 2009, a conference call was held with representatives of the Offices of Nuclear Reactor Regulation (NRR), Nuclear Security and Incident Response (NSIR), and Wolf Creek Nuclear Operating Corporation (WCNOC). During this call the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) identified that some of the items requested for exemption were not needed as they did not represent a change to existing requirements and that additional clarification was needed in order to consider the remaining requests.

Based on this conference call, WCNOC is withdrawing the requests for exemption submitted by References 1 and 2. WCNOC will resubmit a revised request for exemption for the requests that do require consideration.
