

ORDER CONVENING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (Licensee) on October 4, 1976 filed a motion for a prehearing conference in reference to its application for an extension of the period of oncethrough cooling interim operation for Indian Point Station, Unit No. 2. The Regulatory Staff of the Commission issued its Draft Environmental Statement in Mid-July 1976 and the Final Environmental Statement is projected to be issued in late November or early December.

The parties to this proceeding have indicated that either October 27th or 28th, 1976 would be a convenient date for a prehearing conference.

WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, in accordance with the Atomic Energy Act, as amended, and the Rules of Practice of the Nuclear Regulatory



Commission, particularly 10 CFR Section 2.752 thereof, that a prehearing conference shall convene at 10:15 a.m. (EDT), Oct. 27, 1976 in the Hearing Room, First Floor, The Willste Building, 7915 Eastern Avenue, Silver Spring, Maryland. The prehearing conference shall consider those matters contemplated to be included within the scope of 10 CFR Section 2.752.
