NOTICE OF ISSUANCE OF AMENDMENT TO FACILITY
OPERATING LICENSE

Notice is hereby given that the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory

Commission (the Commission) has issued Amendment No. 14 to Facility

Operating License No. DPR-26 issued to Consolidated Edison Company

of New York, Inc. which revised Technical Specifications for operation

of the Indian Point Nuclear Generating Unit No. 2, located in Buchanan,

Westchester County, New York. The amendment is effective as of its

date of issuance.

In accordance with the licensee's application for a license amendment, dated July 23, 1975, the amendment modifies the Technical Specifications by providing additional conditions for the storage of the spent fuel. The amendment also permits modification of the spent fuel element storage pool in order to provide for additional storage capacity for spent fuel in accordance with the licensee's proposal dated March 4, 1975, as supplemented on May 9, July 23, August 19, September 11, October 1, and October 10, 1975.

The application for the amendment complies with the standards and requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended (the Act), and the Commission's rules and regulations. The Commission

has made appropriate findings as required by the Act and the Commission's rules and regulations in 10 CFR Chapter I, which are set forth in the license amendment. Notice of Proposed Issuance of Amendment to Facility Operating License in connection with this action was published in the <u>FEDERAL REGISTER</u> on October 10, 1975 (40 F.R. 47839). No request for a hearing or petition for leave to intervene was filed following notice of the proposed action.
